Highlights Of November and December

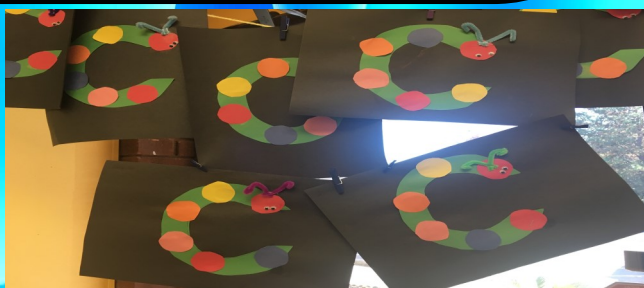
Our class enjoyed a nice fall break and got back ready to learn. MashaAllah, its amazing to see the Students become more independent as we move along our school year :)

Quran: Continue Surat Al-Falaq.

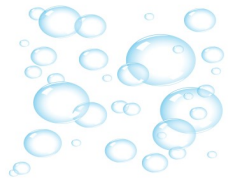
Islamic studies: learning about Muslims manners from Qur'an.
