READ, READ! I can't emphasize enough on having your little one read every-day as well! You may utilize Raz Kids during the Summer in sha Allah.

Please have your rising third grader work on the remaining pages in the workbooks we will send home. This will help them retain concepts learned in second grade in sha Allah.

Establishing a Summer schedule will be the best strategy for success! Talk to your child and establish a "work time" for weekdays. I recommend at least two hours a day! You can further divide the work time into how much time on each task decided as well.

Be consistent! If you and your child agree to 10am -12pm, DO NOT bend the rules, please treat this time like an appointment with your child! This will instill discipline in your child in sha Allah and the consistency will ensure they are practicing skills required for success in the next academic year in sha Allah!
