## **STEAM**

For our STEAM Elementary team 'Bus Repurposing' project, we conducted surveys and invited our seventh and eighth grader students to provide their opinions on the inner use of our salvaged bus. Earlier this year, this old school bus was cleaned, resurfaced, and repainted as part of our Semester 1 Performance Based Assessment Grand Challenge. Then, we are exploring options to repurpose it.

The results of the survey showed that a clear majority of the students wanted to see the inside of this bus used as a quiet room/student lounge/ library. We are currently looking into ways and means to finance our projects and create models of the bus.

#### **WRITING**

We have begun with our Literature Circle discussions and sharing using a writing Lap-Book for guidance through the various stages of the process of Writing. We will work on writing informational reports with an interesting 'Cereal Box' Project in March 2020 in sha Allah.

## Math

Chapter 8 was concluded at the end of January, Alhamdulillah! We are on track with our Math curriculum. In targeting some of the goals in the current chapter, we are practicing basic aspects of fractions, we worked on operations with fractions including addition and subtraction of fractions and problem-solving strategies. This also helped us fill in gaps within our previous basic multiplication and division skills. Our next goal is to master problem-solving investigations using these operations to enhance our divisibility rules and factorization skills.
