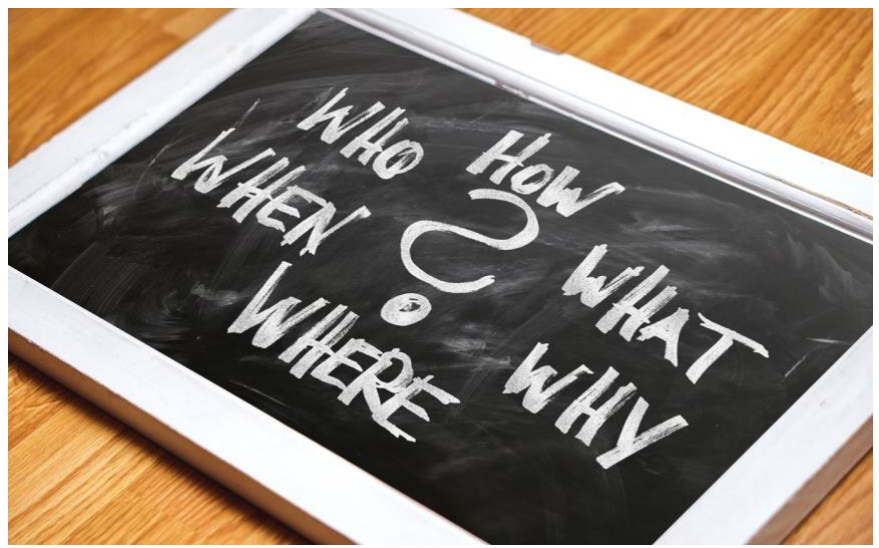


SIXTH GRADE



SOCIAL STUDIES SR. SHAIMA

Last month, students learned about poetry and wrote various types of poetry. This month, students are reading folktales and fables. In addition, students will be writing an informational paper about folktales.

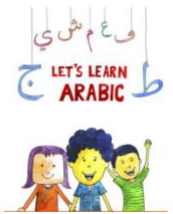
MATH SR. ANAM

Alhamdulillah we have finished the unit on honesty & integrity.

In this unit students have learned the equivalent Arabic words for honesty and integrity. They have also learned new vocabs and expressions. They are able to distinguish between nouns, verbs and adjectives. Students can also distinguish between the three tenses (present, past and future tense), and how to make negation.

In class we have also worked on the important parts of the sentence (verb, noun, preposition, complement) and practiced reading out loud in class to discuss the main ideas. The students were assessed and did amazing. Alhamdulillah all students have improved and have shown a passion to increase their knowledge in learning Arabic.

Students use various reinforcement activities on Kahoot and practicing on Duolingo by reading, writing and listening to help practice.

SR. MISBAH & BR. AHMAD

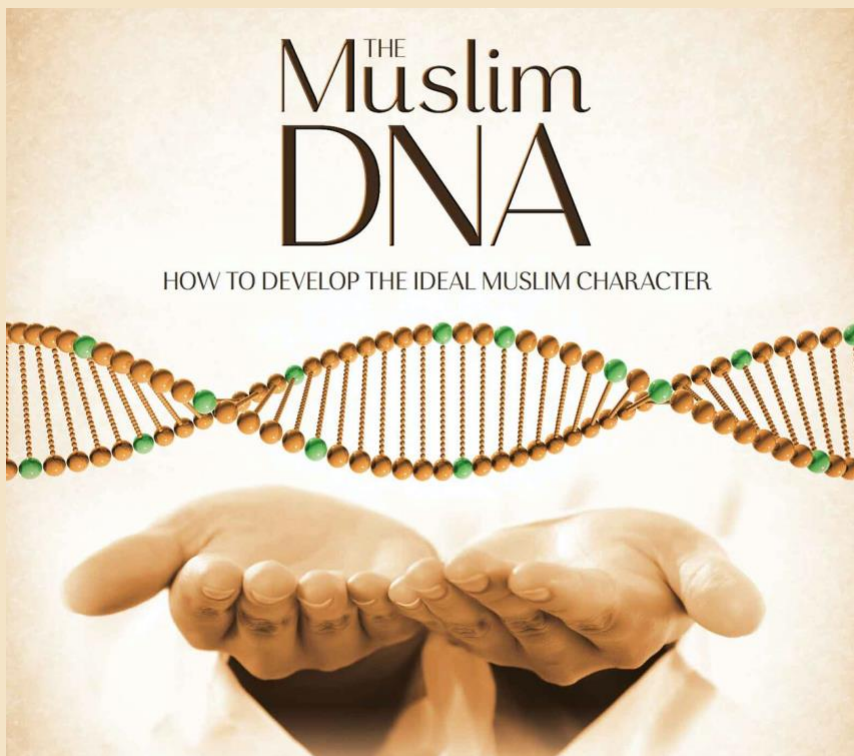


In the Name of Allāh, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful
