

Arabic Newsletter September 2017

1st Grade:

We wrapped unit 1 (اسمي/My name) where students learned how to introduce themselves in Arabic, how to write their names correctly, and letters Meem & Baa (م – ب) sounds and shapes. 1st graders enjoyed making their cupcakes for their names. They learned subject pronouns (I, you male & female/أنا، أنتَ، أنتِ)

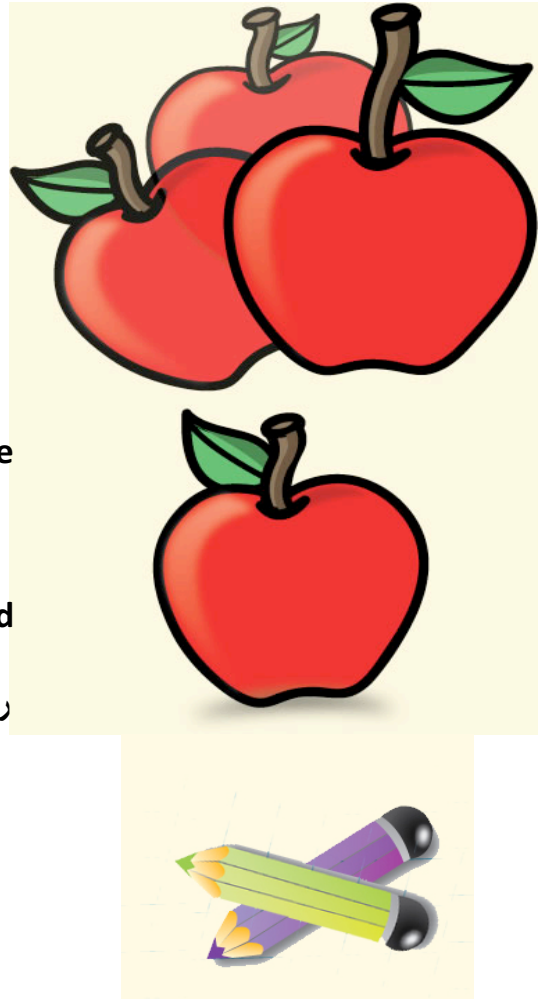
3rd Grade:

Our 3rd graders enjoyed making Eid greeting cards for their families. They finished unit 1 (What is your hobby?/ما هوايتك؟). 3rd graders learned how to tell about their hobby in Arabic, vocabulary words about hobbies, question words and reading a dialogue related.

4th Grade:

4th graders learned about how someone prefer to spend the holidays in unit 1(هل قضيت عطلة سعيدة؟)/Did you spend a happy holiday?

Students learned the question word (Ayna, where/ أين؟) and how to use it. They learned how to recognize the similar letters sounds (place of articulation). They read a text (رحلة ممتعة), they answered questions related to understanding the text and how to put the words to make sentences.



5th Grade:

Our 5th grader finished unit 1 (In the airport/المطار). Our students learned Arabic words about traveling, They learned about singular & dual and sentence structure. They enjoyed making passports, tickets and boarding passes.

6th, 7th, 8th grade, Boys: Our middle school boys just wrapped unit 1 (المحافظة على البيئة) Students read a dialogue about different kinds of fish and how to find solution to keep their sea environment clean and answered questions related. They read a story about (Israff) "سعد في عالم الالعب". They learned about subject pronouns with present verb tense, and sentence structure and similar letters sounds. They presented their Hajj Projects Mashallah.

2nd Garde:

We wrapped unit 1 (السلام عليكم) and just started unit 2 (اسمي صالحة). Second graders learned about the importance of Muslim greeting through story and dialogue. Students interacted among themselves in Arabic. They learned the subject pronouns (I, you, you, he, she) and some vocabulary words related.

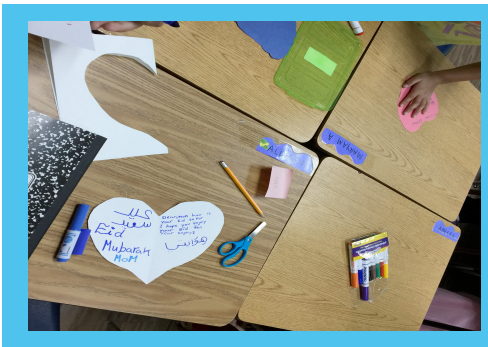
2nd graders learned letters (ت، ط) indifferent shapes and sounds, they learned how to write their names correctly in Arabic. They practiced reading too.

They learned about subject pronouns with present tense verb, sentence structure and similar letters sounds and the beginning hamza in some nouns.
