MONTESSORI ELEMENTARY

Alhumdulilah! Montessori Elementary has finished its two months successfully. The former first grade students were excited to join back to the Montessori environment after a year break as well as the returning first grade level students after their summer break. In the months of August-September, we finished revising most of the previous lessons and learned the newer lessons related to the fundamental teachings to have the complete grasp of it.

<u>Math</u>: E. Montessori learned concrete concepts of place value from ones to thousands, double and triple digit operations, fractions, meanwhile practicing the previously learned lessons of basic math operations, greater and lesser number, and short and long bead chain concepts.

<u>Language</u>: We learned grammar elements, nouns and indefinite and definite articles, and adjectives; sentence structure; reading comprehension; homonyms and synonyms. Also, we are practicing spellings and vocabulary of phonograms and reading excessively.

Zoology: We studied Mammals and amphibians and vital organs of the human body and their functions.

Botany: Parts of leaves and various kinds of leaves are introduced to students.

<u>Geography</u>: E. Montessori students revised the continents and their countries. They created their maps and informally learned about their countries. We also studied about hurricanes or tornadoes, and which one is more dangerous.

Science Experiment: E. Montessori experimented the question: if the shadow of a still-object will move like the shadow of a moving object? Almost all students hypothesized that shadow of the still object will stay on one spot because the object is not moving (how innocent!). To their surprise, the shadow of the quiet shadow moved when they measured the shadow in the sunlight on two different times. Through this experiment, we studied about the Earth's rotation and its relation to objects' shadows on Earth.

<u>Art:</u> E. Montessori replicated one of the Monet's paintings with Sr. Hannan. They learned to mix colors, textures, the difference in the vertical or horizontal horizon of a painting.
