OH THE THINGS WE'VE LEARNED SO FAR! READING

Literature:

First graders were introduced to nonfiction to build their literature skills.

Comprehension:

Students have been continuing to learn to identify the main topic and provide information using illustration. They learned what the characters, setting and events are in a story. They are continuing to identify key details as well as the ability to retell the text.

Vocabulary:

Students were introduced to new vocabulary words, as well as high frequency words. The spelling words were practiced in class in various ways. Ask your child what they would like their occupation to be when they grow older! (Occupation is one of their oral vocabulary words).

Phonics:

Students were introduced to short /u/ and ending consonant blends such as /nd/, /nk/, /nt/, /sk/, /mp/, /sh/, /sh/, /wh/, /ph/, /tch/and /ch/. In the next few weeks, they will be learning thier long vowels.

Writing:

Students have completed their final draft about why they should have an ice cream. They have convinced me that indeed they do deserve an ice cream party. MashaAllah they have worked hard and completed their classwork and homework. Students are now working on what their favorite subject is in school. They have brainstormed their reasons why and have been working on their first and second drafts. Majority of them said P.E was their favorite subject!

LANGUAGE ARTS

First graders learned that there are two kinds of nouns: common and proper nouns. They learned to distinguish between the two. They learned about singular and plural nouns as well. They know that not all nouns follow the plural rule of adding an -s or -e and at the of the word and that some nouns like to make up their rule when there is more than one. Ask your child to give you an example of an irregular plural noun and when do we add an -es to make a noun plural.

MATHEMATICS

Our first graders have been mastering their addition skills and were introduced to subtraction. They learned that addition is the opposite of addition and that we can find missing numbers by switching the numbers around. They were excited to learn about fact families and that a fact family has 2 addition and 2 subtraction sentences. We will continue to use addition and subtraction to solve problems by writing number sentences. We will take a break from numbers and learn about graphs.

SCIENCE

Students learned that animals live in different habitats. They learned that there are two kinds of habitats: land and water. We have been studying about the grasslands and forest for land habitats and lakes and oceans for water habitats. Ask your child what the difference between lake and water habitats and grasslands and forest habitats.





SOCIAL STUDIES

Our first graders learned about the land and resources of different regions. They learned about the different places people can live. They learned that some people choose to live in a rural area such as farms where it is quiet and not too busy and urban areas such as the city where it is loud and busy. They reviewed their four seasons and learned that people do fun activities in each of them. Ask your child what word we use to describe activities people do for fun and give you an example for each of the season.

ARABIC (SR. NAFN)

Assalamu Alaikum, we just wrapped unit 2 (This is My Family) where students learned about their family members. They are learning about items that can be seen in the bathroom. You can ask your child about them. They learned the question word AYNA? Where? And how to use it in unit 3 (Fil Hammam).

They learned new letters' sound and shapes Dal, Lam and Raa with examples as well.

First graders loved the reading game we have in our class.



QURAN (SR. SAUDA)

Assalamu alaikum Dear Respected Parents, Alhamdulilah another month has yet come and gone! Lots has been happening in our Qur'an class! Students have filled their Juz Amma memorization charts with stars for successful completion of suwar all the way up to surah Al-Asr! We focused our learning on Surah At-Takathur, what it is about, reading specific words, and memorizing it with tajweed! We discussed the many bounties and blessings of Allah (SWT), and students had the opportunity to watch a nasheed with their favourite friend Zaky, entitled "Count the Blessings of Allah!" We completed lesson number 8 of Nouraniyya and were introduced to the "vowel and letter friends" that are joined together with the "hiding sukoon". We had a somewhat expected bumpy
