STEAMing Friday

The second graders were busy building a lunar satellite last STEAMing Friday! The challenge was to design and build a satellite that will orbit the moon. It required to have the following criteria:

1. Carry two instruments to investigate

the Moon's surface (represented by buttons) and write a description of what their job will be

2. Withstand a drop from above their head without any pieces falling off

- 3. Have a cylinder and a rectangular prism in the model of the satellite
- 4. Only use the following materials:
- Tape, 1 Toilet paper roll, 3 Straws, Glue, 1 Card Stock, 2 buttons

Alhamdulilah October has been an exciting month with new additions to our Qur'an curriculum! During the past month we reviewed Surah Az-Zalza, Al-Aaadiyat, & Al-Qaari'a, students were tested both on their memorization and reading skills! The reading assessments were a fun and affective addition to the curriculum as students participated in what looked like a word search, except the teacher called out the words and the students rushed to find them in the Surah! To continue our review of past suwar, one per week, we began a "Reach 4 the Stars Challenge" where students are encouraged to prepare the suwar and recite it for a star on their Juz A'mma tally chart, after we have practiced it in class for one week. The student with the most stars accumulated will be rewarded at the end of the quarter, In Sha Allah! Alhamdulilah we have begun our new surah for the quarter, Surah Al-Lail! In Sha Allah we will focus on understanding the Surah, the lessons learnt, recognizing and reading selected words, and reciting it with correct tajweed. In Nouranniya we are on page 3 of lesson 11. It has been a bumpy ride as students strive to get the hang of spelling words with all the rules learnt thus far. In Sha Allah I pray for a quick and successful completion of this lesson!
